- (d) Conducting exercises in Chesapeake Bay. At 1800 rendezvoused with U.S.S. LUDLOW and U.S.S. TRIPPE, off tail of the Horse-shoe Buoy, and departed Chesapeake Bay via swept channel, and proceeded to sea, enroute Navy Yard, New York. At 1900 launched one aircraft armed with two depth charges to assist in attack of submarine reported north of swept channel. At 2030 plane recovered having made no contact with enemy. Comcrudiv-8 (OTC) dispatched the U.S.S. TRIPPE for the same purpose. TRIPPE rejoined without making contact.
