- (e) The O.T.C. received information from COAC Halifax that the SIBONEY and AORANGI were fog bound, and would be delayed in leaving that port. He therefore decided to proceed with the ships present to destination, and detached the destroyer BUCK with Comdesron 13 to join EMMONS and MC COMB in escorting SIBONEY and AORANGI to destination.

PHILADELPHIA, TEXAS and seven destroyers proceeding on prescribed track.
