- (e) At 1115 DD #1 reported submarine contact and at 1122 reported that contact was fish. At 1309 DD #7 reported submarine contact and dropped three barrages of depth charges. No definite results. Between 1332 and 1334 catapulted two planes for anti-submarine patrol. At 1348 DD #3 reported submarine contact, but later reported contact lost. From 1603 to 1606 recovered two aircraft. Received despatch from Cominch re-routing convoy AT-20.
