DAILY WAR DIARY

(a) CHEROKEE, HOWARD and HAMILTON detached to report to Commander Task Force 34.

(d) Position zone zero time:

0800 Lat. 32°-18' N. Long. 09°-21' W.
1200 Lat. 32°-35' N. Long. 10°-05' W.
2000 Lat. 32°-18' N. Long. 09°-21' W.

(e) Proceeded to sea and took fuel oil and gasoline to capacity from U.S.S. SANTEE. Plane No. 3, Pilot Lieut (jg) W.R. Austin, USNR located and bombed a Vichy French submarine which was beached 10 miles north of Cape Blanco putting submarine completely out of action. Plane No. 1, Pilot Lieut (jg) J.E. Mishanec, USNR took photographs of damaged submarine. This is believed to be the same submarine which was attacked by plane No. 5 on 9 November. Maintained continuous A/S patrol. Returned to Fire Support Area No. 8 off Safi, French Morocco.
