ENEMY SHOULD BE EXPECTED. APPEARS THAT AREAS OFF PONZA AND ANZIO
MIGHT BE NEXT SPOTS FOR S/M TO OPERATE. CONTROLLED BOMBING
RESULTED IN LOSS OF HMS INGLEFIELD DURING EVENING OF 25TH OFF ANZIO.

SAME DAY ALSO LOST LST 349 AS RESULT OF GROUNDING OFF PONZA DUE
TO HEAVY WEATHER. PHILADELPHIA SPENT 26TH OFF PONZA, NO FIRING
CALLED FOR. ON 27TH EXPENDED 4Ø7 ROUNDS. ENEMY ARTILLERY ON
