1 to 6 March

- (a) Anchored off FORT DELL'OVO, MAPLES, ITALY in 34 fathoms of water with 130 fathoms of chain to port anchor on the following bearings: FORT DELL'OVO 021°(T), DUCA D'AOSTA LIGHT 064°(T), CARMINE TOWER 034°(T). PHILADELPHIA, with U.S.S. LANSDALE and U.S.S. HILARY P. JONES, operated as Task Group 81.8 (CTG 81.8 in PHILADELPHIA). Task Group 81.8 assigned to Commander Cruiser Squadron 15 (Rear Admiral J.M. Mansfield, R.N. aboard H.M.S. ORION).
- (b) Task Group 81.8 remained at short notice (1/2 hour) to proceed to fire support area off ANZIO. No call received for gunfire support during entire period.

7 to 10 March

.(a) At 071729A underway from NAPLES, ITALY for PALERMO, SICILY screened by U.S.S. LANSDALE and U.S.S. HILARY P. JONES. At 080750A moored port side to Jetty Diga Foranea, PALERMO. Took on fuel, ammunition and provisions. 100759A departed from PALERMO, SICILY with U.S.S. LANSDALE and U.S.S. HILARY P. JONES as screen proceeded to NAPLES, ITALY. 102729 anchored off FORT DELL'OVO, NAPLES in 41 fathoms of water with 150 fathoms of chain to the port anchor. Passage from NAPLES to PALERMO and return was made in accordance with despatch orders of Commander Cruiser Division Eight (CTF 86).

11 March

(a) Oll5 Anti-aircraft batteries ashore commenced firing. No targets reported on radars aboard this vessel. O314 Combat reported unidentified plane in the harbor area. O315 Heavy anti-aircraft fire in harbor area; splash in water bearing O90°(R), distant 40 yards. O318 Sounded General Quarters. O320 Red alert reported over MAPLES. O324 Commenced heaving in chain. O333 Condition White over MAPLES; heavy smoke screen in harbor area as result of smoke pots used by shore and ship units. O344 Secured from General Quarters.
