## SCHEDULE OF EXERCISES

- (c) 1000 At anchor MARSA-XLOKK. PHILADELPHIA will check radar and range finders using tug to hold ship on proper headings.
- (d) Remain at anchor during remainder of day and night. Two (2) PHILADELPHIA planes will arrive and be available for tracking. One (1) plane from MALTA will be requested for altitude calibration of radar.

## THIRD DAY (1 August 1944)

- (a) O600 Underway from MARSA-XLOKK for firing area, South of MALTA.
- (b) 0700 0930 PHILADELPHIA fire A.A. Baker Tare and How Practice on towed sleeve. Each <u>DESTROYER</u> will be allocated firing runs by signal about 0900.
- (c) 1000 1200 PHILADELPHIA catapult planes, rehearse and fire day spotting practice on towed battle raft, using both main and secondary batteries.

  DESTROYERS screen, one ahead and one astern, conforming to movements of PHILADELPHIA.
- (d) 1400 1600 PHILADELPHIA rehearse and fire radar controlled practice at towed battle raft; 5" and 6" batteries.
- (e) 2000 PHILADELPHIA rehearse shore bombardment on FILFOLA ISLAND. DESTROYERS take station ahead and astern.
- (f) 2130 PHILADELPHIA fire illumination and night spotting practice on towed battle raft.
- (g) 2300 Underway to join command.
