3. 2. 3. and 4 June 1945.

(a) Enroute from point Victor to point I-Ray-Sail on 2, 3, and 4 June, the ship conducted general and emergency drills and exercised at general quarters both sunrise and sunset, fire drills, abandon ship, fire and rescue, salvage party, man overboard, and others. Flight operations were also carried out.

(b) At 0648, 4 June, the ship reached point X-Ray-Sail and at 0710 entered the swept channel enroute to Hampton Roads, Virginia. The ship entered Hampton Roads and moored starboard side to north side of pier 5, Naval Operating Base, Hampton Roads, Virginia, at 1325. Ships present included U.S.S.
