Receiving the following services from the dock: fresh, and salt water, steam, electricity, and telephone. 0615 lighted off boiler #6. 0900 received ammunition lighter alongside. 1600 secured boiler #6.
5. 0910 commenced transfer of 1.10/75 caliber ammunition to lighter alongside. 1655 completed transfer of ammunition to lighter, as follows: 1 round 6"/47 cal., SPD 2528, 37933 rounds 1.10/75 cal., SPD 2757, 14 rounds 1.10/75 cal., SPD 2630, 181 rounds 1.10/75 cal., SPD 3026, and sundry tanks, cases, extractors, caps, plugs, spacers, crates, plate-covers, gaskets, and fuzes.
