MK-34 and mods.; 1800 fuses MK29-1; 1800 fuses MK18-2. Transferred the following to N.A.D., SAINT JULIENS, via lighter YF-260: 64800 cartridges, 30 cal. ball; 195 6"/47 empty cases with tanks; 134 5"/25 empty cases with tanks; 21 40MM boxes, with empty cases; and 1440 20MM cases, empty. 1705 H.M.S. CHASER moored starboard side to North side of pier 7.
