20 to 24:

As before. 2113 Darkened ship. 2117 Called away plane handling detail, commenced maneuvering on various courses and at various speeds for recovery of aircraft. 2140 Hoisted on board plane No.2 (Kingfisher Type), from the U.S.S. BIRMINGHAM, Pilot, Ens. Mote U.S.N., passenger Tahl: ARML/c. 2142 Commenced steaming on various courses and at various speeds to resume position in screen. 2218 Regained station in screen. 2313 Lighted fires under boiler #5. 2350 Secured boiler #4
