12 to 16:

As before. 1200 Steaming on various courses and speeds conforming to channel. 1204 Pilot Loreal came aboard. 1254 Line passed to men on mooring buoy "V". 1312 Starboard anchor chain secured to buoy "V". 1320 Pilot Loreal left ship 1330 Moored astern to buoy "W" with one wire line and one manilla line. 1335 Secured boilers #2, #3 and #4. 1355 U.S.S. CHICKOPEE came alongside port side for fueling. 1437 Commenced pumping oil forward.
