As before. 1822 Ceased zig-zagging, resumed base course 180°(T). 1830 Adjusted course to 135°(T). 1840 Adjusted course to 090°(T). 1845 Commenced zig-zagging on plan #11, base course 090°(T). 1908 Adjusted base course to 085°(T). 1913 Adjusted base course to 080°(T). 1915 Sighted mine off port bow, range 3000 yards, fired 30 cal. automatic rifle at mine unsuccessfully. 1945 Ceased zig-zagging, resumed base course 080°(T). 1950 Adjusted course to 110°(T). 1955 Adjusted course to 135°(T).
