As before. 0845 Secured boiler #6. 0915 H.M.S. LCI-120 underway. 0936 H.M.S. L-49 underway. 0945 H.M.S. L-21 underway. 1000 U.S.S. HERNDON underway. 1010 U.S.S. GLENNON underway. 1030 Set special sea details, pilot Gregon came aboard. 1045 Lines to tugs bow and stern. 1055 Line to tug astern cast off. 1056 Underway on various courses at various speeds standing out to anchorage outside nets, pilot at the Conn, Executive Officer and Navigator on the bridge. 1057 Line to tug at bow cast off. 1116 Anchored in 17 fathoms of water with 60 fathoms of chain to starboard anchor, on the following bearings: BREAKWATER LIGHT 243°(T), LEFT TANGENT 063.5°(T), TRIPOD 269.2°(T).
