16 to 20:

As before. 1900 Convoy commenced zig-zagging on plan #11, base course 280° (T). 1800 Returned to station 30° on starboard bow of U.S.S. CROAKIN, distance 1,000 yards. 1800 Changed convoy speed to 15.5 knots. 1900 Set clocks back one hour to conform to zone plus three (3) time.
