At 1400 Zone plus 3 time, transferred Admiral Hewitt to USS EBERLE off Point Judith who proceeded to Newport. ERICCSON proceeded to Navy Yard, New York. PHILADELPHIA proceeded to Hempstead Harbor, Long Island preparatory to proceeding to Navy Yard, New York via Hell Gate on 27 April.
