- (e) S.S. AWATEA, U.S.S.'s CHEMUNG, BUCK, INGRAHAM and BRISTOL not present. INGRAHAM sunk in collision with CHEMUNG. BUCK, CHEMUNG, and AWATEA returning to Halifax under escort of BRISTOL. Reformed main body and screen. 0748 destroyer screen made sound contact and dropped depth charge barrage. No definite results. Contact lost.
