1. 1 August.

- (a) The U.S.S. PHILADELPHIA was attached to Cruiser Division EIGHT, Eighth Fleet, operating in the Mediterranean. The ship had just completed a two months repair period in H.M. Dockyard, Malta.
- (b) During the night 31 July, and early morning of 1 August, the ship was anchored in MARSA-XLOKK Harbor, MALTA. At 0623 the ship got underway, screened by U.S.S. MADISON and U.S.S. NIKIDS, for the firing area south of MALTA to carry out the final phases of a post-repair training plan as set forth in enclosure (A). The remainder of the day was occupied in firing the scheduled practices with main and anti-aircraft batteries. The exercises were carried out with the aid of the ship's planes.
 - (c) At 2311 course was set for PALERMO, Sicily.
