- (h) Communications with Battle raft tug on 2150 kcs W/T.
- (i) CTF 86 current voice code will be used throughout this training operation. Voice call signs assigned as follows:
PHILADELPHIA - LEFTWOOD.
NIELDS - SEAWEED.
MADISON - PLATFORM.
- (j) All contacts are to be reported to O.T.C. over primary frequency.
- (k) Zone minus 2 (BAKER) will be used in all communications within this unit.
- (l) O.T.C. in PHILADELPHIA.
