1200 - 31°38' N, 58°03'W.

2000 - 31°24.1'N, 60°42'W.

5. 4 November 1944.

(a) Steaming on course 264°T, speed 15 knots. At 1345 changed base course to 321°T, changed speed to 20 knots; 1515 reduced speed to 15 knots.

(b) Position:

0800 - 31°27'00"N, 64°06'00"W.

1200 - 31°57'00"N, 65°30'00"W.

2000 - 33°24.5' N, 67°27'18"W.

6. 5 November 1944.

(a) The unit was steaming on base course 315°T, speed 15 knots. Destroyers on normal screening position on either bow. 0803 changed base course to 318°T; changed speed to 14 knots.

(b) Position:

0800 - 35°21.2'N, 69°68.5'W.

1200 - 36°02' N, 70°47' W.

2000 - 37°19.5'N, 72°19'W.

7. 6 November 1944.

(a) With the U.S.S. EBERLE and the U.S.S. LIVERMORE in normal screening positions the unit was steaming on base course 318°T, speed 12 knots. 0100 U.S.S. LIVERMORE and U.S.S. EBERLE took departure and proceeded on duty assigned in accordance with Commanding
