- 4. 0300 commenced zigzagging on plan #11, base course 225°(T). 0658 catapulted plane 8-CS-4, with Lieut.(JG) Mishanec as pilot, and Dristy RM2/c as passenger, and plane 8-CS-5 with Lieut.(JG) Coughlin as pilot, and Dristy ARM2/c as passenger. 0730 lighted ship. 0755 made emergency turn to 295°(T). 0807 changed course to 250°(T). 0815 changed course to 225°(T). 0820 changed base course by wheeling to 257°(T). Took on 54.5 tons of salt water ballast in tanks B-923F, and B-924F. 0850 catapulted plane 8-CS-2 with Lieut.(JG) Austin pilot, and Gibbson RM3/c as passenger. 0900 held Gemeral Quarters for drill; set material condition "Able". 0947 secured from material condition "Able", and set material condition "Baker-Plus". 0956 secured from General Quarters.
