08 to 12:

As before. Hoisted plane 8-CS-5 aboard. 0830 hoisted out plane 8-CS-2, with Lieut. (jg) Fierstein pilot, and Lieut. (jg) Haberstroh passenger. 0945 lighted fires under boiler #1. 1015 lighted fires under boilers #5, and #6. 1104 hoisted out plane 8-CS-1, with Lieut. Mishanec pilot, and Lieut. Comdr. Raymond Passenger. 1106 hoisted out plane 8-CS-5, with Lieut. (jg) Lawry pilot, and Gideon AMM2/c as passenger. 1114 hoisted out plane 8-CS-4, with Lieut. Comdr. Stevenson pilot, and Fisher AMM 2/c as passenger. Note: expended the following ammunition for test firing this date: 36 rounds 40MM, and 180 rounds 20MM. 1115 set special sea details. 1144 underway, with Captain at the conn, Executive Officer, and Navigator on the bridge. On various courses, and at various speeds for "Baker-2" firing practice. 1149 catapulted plane 8-CS-5, with Lieut. (jg) Lawry pilot, and Gideon, AMM2/c as passenger.

Position: 36°49'00"N., 76°18'00"W. 1315 commenced firing 5" battery for "Baker-" practice. 1340 commenced firing 20MM, and 40MM guns. 1418 completed practice firing, having expended: 10 rounds 5", 36 rounds 40MM, and 368 rounds 20MM ammunition. 1420 proceeding to NAVY YARD, PORTSMOUTH, VIRGINIA.

Boiler #5 steaming for auxiliary purposes. 1855 commenced receiving fresh, and salt water from the dock. U.S.S. ANDROMEDA underway.
