As before. 0055 Ceased zig-zagging and resumed base course 301°(T). 0108 Changed speed to 5 knots (50 RPM). 0115 U.S.S. BIRMINGHAM, plus U.S.S. EDISON and U.S.S. LUDLOW joined formation. ComCruDiv EIGHT in this vessel O.T.C. 0121 Changed course to 030°(T), passing through Tunisian war channel. 0127 Changed speed to 10 knots (100 RPM). 0150 Changed speed to 15 knots (150 RPM). 0259 Changed course to 340°(T). 0305 Radar Plot reported surface target. Destroyer investigated. Reported small craft travelling at high speed. Vessel did not properly answer challenge. 0330 Sighted Cape Bon Light bearing 310°(T).
