18 to 20:
(Cont'd). Cleared ship astern, stopped all engines. 1824 Completed transfer of 127,685 gal fuel to Navy Yard Tanker. 1825 Commenced using engines as necessary preparatory to getting underway. 1835 Underway from GRAVESEND BAY, enroute to BROOKLYN NAVY YARD, New York. Captain at the Conn, Executive Officer and Navigator on the bridge. 1857 Received Navy Yard Pilot BARNES on board.
